## Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Haley at 3:47 p.m.

## Minutes Approval

Shalice made a motion to approve the minutes from November. Missy seconded. Minutes approved.

## Agenda items:

1. Review data
  - a. Jill summarized the district benchmarks. With as crazy as this year is, we are right where we need to be. Math is especially good, 5th and 6th grade is doing great. 3rd grade is doing well, even with two new teachers.
  - b. Used Title 1 money to buy Reflex Math to improve fluency. Trustlands money for next week.
  - c. Purchased Building Fath Fluency kits for conceptional work with fluency.
  - d. FOSS science kits arriving any day.
  - e. ELA is not as strong as it has been in the past. Suffering more than Math is in this COVID world. Interventions changed to 15 minutes rather than 45 minutes. 95% Blitz changing back to 25 minutes rather than only 15.
  - f. BLT Math: Reflex Math, FOSS training for teachers, Training when COVID restrictions are lifted.
  - g. \$52,931 funds for next year

- i. Headphones and Computer mouse (we could ask teachers what they need for the students.)
  - ii. Differentiated PD: Jill will ask teachers what they want (Restorative Practices, Eureka, FOSS) Would they do it for extra pay? Are those district days or school specific days?
- 2. Review safe walking route
  - a. Yearly Review:
    - i. boundaries and crossing points haven't changed
    - ii. Sidewalk is going in on Cedar for students to walk safely.
    - iii. Walking route isn't the quickest, but safest because of sidewalks. (Lindsay said that Jefferson doesn't have sidewalks.)
    - iv. Missy said the crosswalk by 5900 South is still dangerous. Students aren't going to the corner to cross; they are older students on wheels. Bassel mentioned that parents aren't driving carefully through the pick up area. Jill will put reminder in her announcements. Shalice mentioned that students are impulsive and in a hurry. Haley asked if we have ever had Safety Patrol at Liberty. Sheri asked if we have repeat offenders have a conversation with teachers? Jill mentioned the Safety Assembly with Tara. It's been for lower grades, but maybe we need to include upper grades as well. Jill asked for any suggestions on making our routes safer. Some requests to the city weren't approved.
    - v. Sheri made a motion to approve the safe walking route. Lindsay seconded. All were in favor. Motion passed.
